National Bylaws: Standing Rule # 14

A Sigma Beta of the Year will be chosen from letters submitted by the chapters. Three outside judges shall make the selection.

NOTE: Letter writers; please follow the guidelines to give your candidate the best opportunity to win. State her sorority achievements first.

The candidate’s qualifications must be based on the objectives of the sorority:

- A. To promote the organization of Sigma Beta Chapters.
- B. To promote charitable and cultural endeavors, and to benefit all members in a social way.
- C. To promote fellowship among the various chapters of this sorority.

RULES for Entry Letter:

- A. Write a two page, double-spaced letter to nominate your candidate.
- B. Complete the attached form on family background, sorority background and outside activities.
- C. Do not mention the nominee’s name, chapter city or state in the letter or background form. Enclose this information in a sealed envelope and attach it to the letter.
- D. All entries must be postmarked no later than midnight October 1st.

Only letters containing outstanding achievements from October 1st to September 30th will qualify. Letters containing previous year’s activities will be disqualified.
